## Re: Years 9, 10 & 11 Christmas Reward Trips

In order to reward pupils with an excellent behaviour record, we have organised a series of Christmas reward trips, which will take place on **Thursday 20<sup>th</sup> December 2018**. You will find the choice of activities available on the reverse of this letter. Pupils are permitted to wear non-uniform to school and should dress appropriately.

### Please note that:

- **Care should be taken when making your choice, as once the trip has been booked you CANNOT TRANSFER TO ANOTHER TRIP AND NO REFUNDS WILL BE GIVEN.**
- **Once accepted onto the trip, if your child withdraws or is removed as a result of any issues that may affect the health and safety requirement of others, then any monies paid will be non-refundable.**
- **Hollingworth Academy is a cashless site and payments for trips cannot be made in cash.**
- **If payment has not been made by the deadline date your child will not be eligible for the trip.**

Please note that pupils eligible for the trips who do not want to participate will be in school at the normal time on that day and will be rewarded with in-school activities.

### WISEPAY BOOKINGS – EXTERNAL TRIPS

Places on some trips are limited and will be awarded on a first come first served basis. Although Hollingworth heavily subsidise each trip we do ask for a contribution (as stated). WisePay will open for trip payments on **Friday 30<sup>th</sup> November at 8.30am** and close on **Friday 7<sup>th</sup> December at 12pm NOON**. Once the deadline on Friday 7<sup>th</sup> December has expired, no more trips can be booked.

### BOOKINGS – IN-SCHOOL ACTIVITIES

Again, places are limited and will be awarded on a first come first served basis. Pupils are to report to Mr Wawrzyn in **Reception** to reserve their place. Bookings are open from **Thursday 6<sup>th</sup> December** and close on **Tuesday 11<sup>th</sup> December**.

Please discuss the options overleaf with your child and then complete the online application (if choosing an external trip) and payment through WisePay. On WisePay, you will be asked to:

- Choose which trip your child will attend.
- Amend any medical information.
- Pay for the trip (if required).
- Acknowledge if a Free School Meal is required.
- By clicking purchase, you are giving permission for your child to attend the trip and confirm that you have read and accepted the conditions in the school's Contract of Behaviour.
