As part of our commitment to raising the aspirations of all our pupils, we are taking the entire Year 7 cohort to Manchester University. We believe this is an opportunity to give all pupils a brief insight into university life and one that we hope will encourage them to consider university as a genuine aspiration. Details are as follows:

- Venue:** The University of Manchester.
Date: Tuesday 23rd April 2019.
Transport: Coach from school to venue and return.
Time: We will depart from school at 9am and return back to school by 1.30pm for lunch.
Dress Code: Full school uniform. **NB:** your child does not need to bring their school bag with them on this day.
Contribution: Free.

Their form tutor and several members of staff, including Mr Kojder (Deputy Headteacher) and Mrs Aubin (Head of Year 7) will accompany the group.

We intend offering all the pupils a light breakfast snack and drink before departure, as there is no facility at the University for food. We, therefore, ask you to encourage your child to arrive in school at 8.30am.

Following lunch, the pupils will go to their respective tutor groups for debriefing and an evaluation of the day. We hope this experience will help to raise the aspirations of all our pupils. We would appreciate it if you could follow this up at home with your child by discussing what they have seen and learnt.
